

Decisions for CPS Referrals Received during SFY 2019-2020

SCDSS - Division of Accountability, Data, and Research (data from CAPSS on November 1, 2020)

Note: In January 2012 the SCDSS developed the use of Community-Based Prevention Services (CBPS) to work with families who had been reported, but intake staff determined (1) the child's safety was not at risk but (2) the family might benefit from some voluntary services. Intake staff use an intake assessment tool which guides them through an evaluation of the safety and risk of all children in the home and helps them make referrals to services that best meet the needs of the children and family.
