



What are EBT Perks?

Established in 2022, the South Carolina Department of Social Services created a program that allows families who receive SNAP benefits to use their EBT cards at participating local attractions.

EBT Perks allows SNAP household members to get free or discounted admission to some of South Carolina's leading attractions. Those wishing to use the perks must present their EBT card and a valid government-issued photo ID at the entrance of participating attractions.

(Incentives and/or discounts are subject to change at the discretion of the participating attraction.)
