Light Your Candle: Encourage Self-motivation, Self-determination, and Self-advocacy in Youth

- 1. Motivate youth to become more independent to prepare for real-world situations.
- 2. Communicate the resources and opportunities available to youth.
- 3. Know when to become involved, when to step back, and when to let youth make decisions.
- 4. Model and explain the importance of self-advocacy.
- 5. Give youth options to encourage self-advocacy and provide them with opportunities to develop skills for independence.

"Watts" in Store?: Be a Guiding Light for Youth in Transition

- Inspire youth and lead by example in knowledgeable, positive and confident living.
- 2. Respect the boundaries of communication.
- 3. Be aware of youth's fears as they transition into adulthood (e.g. finances, getting a job, education, finding a place to live)
- 4. Plan quality time to engage with youth and build a relationship based on trust, respect, and common interests.
- 5. Be prepared, be patient, and keep checking in with youth.

Dispel the Darkness: Accept a Youth's Individuality

- Understand and accept that a youth's perspective and experiences may be different from your own.
- 2. Be mindful of generational differences and encourage individuality and respectful input.
- 3. Encourage youth to discover personal goals and ways to reach them.
- 4. Respect a youth's religious beliefs and practices. Support them as they explore their faith.
- 5. Respect youth's right to be unique in every way, including sexual orientation, without having to defend or explain themselves.
