The South Carolina Department of Social Services (SCDSS) is looking to hire a well-educated, trained workforce to work with children and families served by the state's child welfare system. Our program provides financial tuition assistance to select undergraduate-level social work majors who will commit to working with the children and families served by SCDSS for a minimum of two years after graduation.

## Our program includes Case Manager postions in:

- Intake
- Investigations
- Family Preservation
- Foster Care
- Adoptions
- Independent Living

#### What are the benefits?

- Tuition assistance up to \$5,000 for the last three semesters of the BSW program for qualifying social work courses.
- A certificate of completion from the program upon meeting all requirements, which includes Child Welfare Academy Preservice Certification at SCDSS
- Assistance in obtaining employment in child welfare services at SCDSS upon graduation
- A career at SCDSS in child welfare

## What is the commitment?

- Maintain full-time enrollment in a BSW Program at one of the participating state of South Carolina universities social work programs.
- Complete and meet all background check requirements.
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher in social work classes, and 2.5 GPA or higher in all coursework
- Complete field placement in child welfare services at SCDSS including completion of the Child Welfare Academy Preservice Certification.
- Must be able to attend Internship on Fridays and one other day of the week selected by the student
- Commit to obtaining employment with SCDSS in the child welfare services following graduation and maintain fulltime employment for at least two years.
