Local interagency staffing teams identify the foster children who have significant <u>emotional or behavioral issues</u>, requiring them to need a therapeutic placement and special services paid with <u>ISCEDC funds</u> (funds which are provided from several state agencies). The chart below tabulates the placement type for each ISCDEC eligible youth on Mar 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. Person funding eligibility data and CMACC data are used to identify ISCEDC funding eligible children and their level of care placement types.
