Personally appeared before me the affiant Special Agent Patrick W. Young of the South Carolina Department of Social Services, Office of Inspector General, who being duly sworn, deposes and says that the defendant, Keondra LaCourtney Williams-Jackson (B/F; DOB [REDACTED] SCDL: [REDACTED] did within the County of Dorchester and State of South Carolina from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2022 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

Fraudulent Acquisition or Use of Food Stamps (Greater than \$10,000)
16-13-430 (A)(1)(C)(1)

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the following facts:

That the defendant, Keondra LaCourtney Williams-Jackson, also known as Keondra Williams, in Dorchester County, during the period of January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2022, did knowingly and willfully by means of false statement and representation fraudulently receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, based on the submission of twelve (12) annual certification and/or semiannual recertification forms dated, January 12, 2018, April 17, 2018, June 4, 2018, December 17, 2018, October 1, 2019, July 28, 2020, December 8, 2020, July 7, 2021, July 20, 2021, December 14, 2021, June 6, 2022 and December 19, 2022, where the defendant willingly and knowingly, failed to report her husband, Edrick Levarr "EJ" Jackson and his income from Eagle Transport, in her household composition on the aforementioned forms during the period, as required. As a result, the defendant received an over issuance of \$28,036.00 in SNAP benefits in which she was not entitled to receive.

Facts to establish the above charge against the defendant, Keondra LaCourtney Williams-Jackson, are based on records, and the statement of witnesses. Based on the above there is probable cause to believe that the defendant violated South Carolina Code of Laws Section 16-13-430 (A)(1)(C)(1).
