Capacity Building for Family Resource Center in Richland County Request for Grant Applications Questions and Answers

1. Will there be a continuation of funding after September 2025?

State's Response: As outlined in the RFGA, the goal of this grant is to support capacity building of a Family Resource Center during the project period and does not guarantee future funding. However, over the course of the project period SCDSS will work with the Grantee to determine sustainability strategies, outcomes, and possible future funding opportunities.

2. We are a group home/residential facility for young males ages from 12-21 who are under the DSS care. We are not located in Richland County; however, we can house boys from Richland County. Would we qualify for this particular grant? State's Response: The focus of this funding opportunity is for the development of a Family Resource Center in Richland County. Eligible providers must meet the minimum qualifications as outlined in the request for grant application. Eligible applicants must have a minimum of three (3) years' experience administering community-based programs or family support models in South Carolina through contracts, grants, or other arrangements. The applicant must be in "good standing" as a provider with SCDSS and located in South Carolina.

3. Will there be grant applications available for Sumter County?

State's Response: At this time this funding opportunity is only available for capacity building of a Family Resource Center in Richland County. SCDSS may consider future scaling and funding opportunities at the conclusion of the project period.
