

Decisions for CPS Referrals Received during SFY 2025-2026

SCDSS - Division of Accountability, Data, and Research (data from CAPSS on August 1, 2026)

Note: In January 2012 the SCDSS developed the use of community services referred to as Family Centered Community Support Services (FCCSS) to work with families who had been reported, but intake staff determined (1) there wasn't a safety threat to the child but (2) the family might benefit from some voluntary services to address potential risk factors. Intake staff use an intake assessment tool which guides them through an evaluation of the safety and risk of all children in the home and helps them make referrals to services that best meet the needs of the children and family.
