Personally appeared before me the affiant Special Agent Patrick W. Young of the South Carolina Department of Social Services, Office of Inspector General, who being duly sworn, deposes and says that the defendant, Tabatha Brook Wyndham (W/F; DOB: [REDACTED] SCDL: [REDACTED]), did within the County Berkeley and State of South Carolina from August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2022 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:



The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the following facts:


That the defendant, Tabatha Brook Wyndham, in Berkeley County, during the period of August 1, 2018 to July 31, 2022, did knowingly and willfully by means of false statement and representation, fraudulently receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, based on the submission of eight (8) annual certification and/or semiannual recertification forms, dated July 16, 2018, January 10, 2019, July 17, 2019, January 15, 2020, August 20, 2020, January 14, 2021, July 22, 2021 and January 18, 2022, where the defendant willingly and knowingly, failed to report her employment and income from Coastal Pediatric Associates PA, as required during the SNAP benefit period. Additionally, the defendant also failed to report her husband, Joshua Russell, and his income from employment with G4S Secure Solutions and The Whiting-Turner Contracting Company, as required during the SNAP benefit period. As a result, the defendant received an over issuance of \$34,419.00 in SNAP benefits she was not entitled to receive.

Facts to establish the above charge against the defendant, Tabatha Brook Wyndham, are based on records, and the statement of witnesses. Based on the above there is probable cause to believe that the defendant violated South Carolina Code of Laws Section 16-13-430.
