During FFY2025, the State Disbursement Unit (SDU) processed over \$405 M in child support collections. Income withholding collections amounted to more than **\$256 M** and represent 66% of all collections.\*<sup>5</sup>

**CSSD collected over \$17.9 M** in past due child support in FFY 2025 through IRS and state tax intercept programs<sup>5</sup>.
