SCDSS- Division of Early Care and Education (DECE) serves as the state's Child Care Development Fund lead agency. Lead Agencies must have the capability to efficiently capture and provide timely responses to federal and state inquiries regarding a wide range of topics and supports related to the child care workforce, to track and link child care provider's participation and compliance with quality improvement standards/initiatives, and identify strategies/services that impact the overall quality of child care are indicative of the need for a comprehensive child care data management system. The former information technology/software contractor worked closely with the DECE's staff to make improvements to, and sustain capabilities of, the former system However due to business/clientele expansion and change of focus they were no longer able work with the DECE.

Describe the Market Based on Research Performed: (See instructions on last page for guidance)

SCDSS-DECE originally began contracting with New World Now (NWN), LLC in January 2019 under a sole source contract. Prior to execution of the contract, DECE's staff devoted substantial time contacting other states with similar needs and interests as South Carolina's about their experiences and processes to select a software company to develop and implement an early care and education integrated data management system. Contact was made with Michigan, New York, Montana, and Minnesota regarding their work with NWN. The staff also sought guidance regarding this initiative from the National Workforce Registry Alliance. The Alliance promotes use of efficiently designed professional development management systems that capture comprehensive information about the workforce. The information helps to identify the basis for establishing learning opportunities for the workforce, strategies for improving the quality of child care, and guidance for policy makers.

NWN designed and developed the Insight system, a proprietary comprehensive early care system which they have exclusive rights. NWN only sells directly to clients. The agency was unable to find a competitor to NWN's Insight system: a system uniquely designed to combine the core functions of an early care education professional development registry, quality rating and improvement features, and continuous quality improvement components into a single comprehensive web-based data management system.

Based on the functionality of the Insight system, information obtained from other states, information from National Workforce Registry Alliance, and NWN's experience with development and maintenance of early care and education professional development registry and learning management systems, it was determined they were only company with the capability to meet the needs of SCDSS-DECE. The agency has continued to contract with NWN as they are the exclusive provider of Insight which assures continued access to the proprietary data system.

In addition, NWN had established Professional Development Registry and Quality Rating Improvement System Consortiums. Membership is offered to all NWN's contractors at no cost. Benefits of these memberships have led to sharing costs with other states to add/expand features,

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access to any previously built reports at little/no cost, participation in discussion of national ECE topics, and opportunities to provide input/feedback regarding topics specifically related to system enhancements. No other vendors provide this option for contractors.

The Insight system includes core features of a comprehensive ECE professional development registry system, the QRIS system, and a continuous quality improvement (CQI) system. The information contained within the registry system provides valuable data across multiple areas regarding the early childhood workforce through the training system, the statewide early childhood career ladder, and the statewide credentialing system. Within the professional development system, the DECE is able to track the required child care training hours for compliance with the agency's Child Care Licensing regulations. In addition, the system tracks trainers and training courses to offer statewide learning opportunities for child care providers. A contracted partner with SCDSS-DECE, Palmetto Shared Services Alliance, uses the systems' learning management system product to offer training seamlessly through the registry system. Within the CQI system, each three SCDSS-DECE funded partners documents technical assistance events offered to child care programs statewide. These events are coordinated between all funded partner agencies and leads to increased continuous quality improvement as well as data regarding improvements within child care programs quality rating. In addition, the system encompasses the consumer education platform with the state's Child Care Resource and Referral agency to provide parents with locating programs serving children in SC. These functionalities strengthen the DECE capability to readily provide data regarding services made available to support child care providers across the state. Inclusive to this contract, NWN provides Support and Maintenance for the web-based data management system.

Explain why the described solution is the only solution that meets the agency's need and how no other identified solutions were sufficient. (See instructions on last page for guidance)

SCDSS-DECE is continuing with progressive efforts to establish and maintain a multifunctional web-based early care and education workforce data management system. New World Now LLC is the sole proprietary creator of Insight. The functionalities of the Insight system combine and enhances core functions of the ECE professional development registry, the quality rating and improvement system, and continuous quality improvement/learning management into a single comprehensive data system. Continuing to contract with New World Now assures access to the Insight system and avoids disruption to existing setups, operation, and enhancements.

Additionally, NWN is the only software company that has made consortiums available to states for both the professional development registry and quality rating improvement systems. The

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consortiums facilitate coordination of services and partnerships with other states using the Insight platform. As a result, SCDSS-DECE receives enhancements and/or system upgrades at no cost, or lower cost that can be used within the system. Some examples of additional development that were received as a result of the consortiums includes:

New York - QRIS- Ability to change a pathway after case is in Accepted Status

Oklahoma - Registry - Email to Org when Employment is Ended

Michigan - Registry - Allow Trainers/TSOs to remove attendees from the rosters of their own events

Michigan - Add Event to Calendar Feature

In addition, SCDSS-DECE was able to offer the SC BOO\$T, Wage enhancement module, to disperse the federal ARPA funding, because Oklahoma had previously developed a module for this type of activity. This significantly reduced the cost of providing this important service for individuals within the child care workforce. NWN's grant module is a feature that was previously developed by North Dakota, and as a result, was configured for SC's use to offer the Business Start-Up Grants using federal funds in 2024. SCDSS-DECE will continue to benefit from other state's initiatives that can be used to implement and/or enhance programs and products in the state's system.
