Personally appeared before me the affiant Alexander R Nguyen who  
being duly sworn deposes and says that defendant Monique White Mccrea  
did within this county and state on or about 11/1/2020 violate the criminal laws of the  
State of South Carolina (or ordinance of  County/  Municipality of Williamsburg)  
in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Food / Food stamps, fraudulent acquisition or use of, value of \$10,000 or more

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit  
the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

That the defendant, Monique McCrea, in Williamsburg County, during the periods of November 2020 through April 2021 and  
February 2022 through September 2024, did knowingly and willfully by means of false statement and representation fraudulently  
obtain Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, based on her submission of seven (7) SNAP Application  
Forms, dated 10/12/2020, 02/28/2022, 07/19/2022, 01/09/2023, 07/17/2023, 01/24/2024, 08/01/2024. On these application forms,  
the defendant stated she lived at 21 Jerusalem Dr., Kingstree SC, 29556 and listed only herself and her six minor children as  
household members. The defendant willfully excluded her cohabitating husband, Jerome McCrea, and his income from these  
applications. As a result, the defendant received an overpayment of \$38,376 in SNAP benefits throughout the claim period which  
she was not entitled to receive. (See Attachment).
