Personally appeared before me the affiant Special Agent Alexander R. Nguyen of the South Carolina Department of Social Services, Office of Inspector General, who being duly sworn, deposes and says that the defendant, Shareita Johnson, did within the County of Sumter and State of South Carolina on or about 08/13/2018 through 04/30/2023 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particulars:

**DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE**

**Fraudulent Acquisition of Food Stamps Greater than \$10,000**

**16-13-0430(A)(1)**

The affiant states that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime(s) set forth, and that such probable cause is based upon the following facts:

That the defendant, Shareita Johnson, in Sumter County, during the periods of 08/13/2018 through 04/30/2023, did knowingly and willfully by means of false statement and representation fraudulently obtain Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits, based on her submission of ten (10) SNAP Application Forms, dated 08/13/2018, 1/15/2019, 06/28/2019, 1/15/2020, 07/16/2020, 01/13/2021, 07/12/2021, 01/14/2022, 07/14/2022, 02/02/2023. On these application forms, the defendant submitted forty-one (41) fraudulent pay statements from "GPM Investments LLC." indicating she received between \$448.08-\$575.72 for each pay period. An investigation revealed that Jenkins earned significantly more than what she reported from her employer, GPM Investments LLC. The defendant's underreported income resulted in an overpayment of \$48,007.00 in SNAP benefits throughout the claim period which she was not entitled to receive. The facts to establish probable cause are based upon records obtained, statements from GPM employees Linda Mosby and Heather Yule, the defendant's wage history from GPM Investments LLC., and OIG Investigation (Case No. 217694).
