# If You Need Food Assistance, You May Qualify For A New Program To Better Serve The Nutritional Needs of Senior Citizens.

## What Is The Elderly Simplified Application Project (ESAP)?

A project to simplify the application process for a segment of our population facing barriers to participation in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly the Food Stamp Program, due to the complexity of the application process and problems associated with age, such as transportation, mobility and disability.

## Who Qualifies?

You may receive food assistance if:

- All members of your household who purchase and prepare food together are 60 years old or older;
- The members of your household are not working;
- You are not already receiving SNAP through SCCAP;
- Your household is under the income limits to be eligible for SNAP participation.

## How Do I Apply?

- You don't have to go to a DSS office to apply.
- You can call 1-888-898-0055 and an application will be mailed to you.
- You don't have to have a face-to-face interview.

Once you are approved, your food benefits go into a special account and we send you a plastic electronic benefit transfer (EBT) card to use every month for buying groceries. Your EBT card works just like a bank debit card at the grocery store.
