SPECIALIZED FOSTER HOME SERVICES

ntensive Foster Care and Clinical Services (IFCCS), formerly known as Managed Treatment Services (MTS), is a division of the South Carolina Department of Social Services. IFCCS was established in 1996 to provide intensive case management services to emotionally disturbed children. These children are in the custody of South Carolina Department of Social Services and are being considered for or reside in out-of-home placements

In expanding its efforts to better serve children, IFCCS is offering Specialized Foster Home Services (SFHS). SFHS is substitute care for those children who require out-of-home care in a setting that is small, intimate and treatment oriented. Typically, these are children who are experiencing a variety of social, emotional and behavioral difficulties because of abuse and/or neglect.



pecialized Foster Home Services is an intensive treatment program for foster children exhibiting special needs. SFHS incorporates clinical treatment services within a supportive and specialized foster home setting. SFHS was originally known as Public Therapeutic Foster Care, and later become Specialized Foster Home Services which is a division of DSS and Intensive Foster Care Clinical Services. SFHS children are served in the least restrictive environment appropriate to their needs.



Foster Parents of SFHS are licensed through the South Carolina Department of Social Services according to state standards and are offered extensive training and support. All SFHS foster parents are supported by a professional support team, who will work closely with you and your family throughout

the placement. During placement Specialized Foster Parents are provided with 24-hour on-call assistance and regular respite care.
